



Scholarships and Grants

At CreatEd Institute, we understand that an investment in schooling is also an investment in your future, and we are committed to helping make your education at CreatEd Institute possible. Below you will find a number of scholarship and grant opportunities that can help you fund your education.

CreatEd Institute does not currently accept federal or state aid. Limited aid/discounts issued by CreatEd Institute are available and articulated below:

Scholarships offered for CreatEd Institute are:

Early Enrollment Scholarship

This scholarship is offered based on the date of an accepted student's submission of their enrollment deposit. There are two tiers of award given for this scholarship: \$1,000 off tuition or \$750 off tuition. The awarded amount is divided into four semester payments. The awarded amount is deducted from the student's overall costs, and applied by the billing department each semester.

For the Fall 2018 cohort, the early enrollment scholarship deadlines are:

- a. **\$1,000 off – April 14th, 2018**
- b. **\$750 off – June 30th, 2018**

Affiliate Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to students who graduate from one of the participating affiliate programs and who **do not** claim their award as a travel voucher for a campus visit.

- a. **Summit Ministries** - students must have completed the entire coursework from Summit Session or Summit Semester in order to qualify for this scholarship. The awarded amount is \$1,000, divided into four semester payments of \$250. The awarded amount is deducted from the student's overall costs, and applied by the billing department for each semester. If the affiliated student elects to claim their award in the form of a travel voucher for a campus visit, they forfeit the awarded amount to be applied to their overall costs.

C. S. Lewis Writers Scholarship

In honor of C. S. Lewis, the Lewis Foundation has come alongside CreatEd Institute to launch the C. S. Lewis Writers Scholarship for young people who wish to be a redemptive cultural voice in society. The C. S. Lewis Writers Scholarship will be a \$2,000 scholarship granted by CreatEd Institute to (up to) three students per incoming cohort and the amount will be distributed over the first four semesters. In order to qualify for the C. S. Lewis Writer's Scholarship, students must write a 500-750 word essay according to one of the following prompts:

1. Watch the [VIDEO](#) of CreatEd Institute's Program Director, Kevin Jenson, speak on the importance of pursuing the truth in love and provide a personal reflection.
2. Tell us what it would mean for you to influence culture through the gifts, talents, and desires God has placed in you.
3. Choose any piece by C. S. Lewis and provide a reflection of the impact it's had on your life.

The awarded amount is deducted from the student's overall costs, and applied by the billing department for each semester. Essay submissions should be sent to pikeda@created.education by **June 30th, 2018** for the Fall 2018 cohort. Recipients who are awarded this scholarship will be notified on **July 15th, 2018** and given time to accept the scholarship.

Grants provided by the CreatEd Institute are:

CreatEd Grant

As part of their application, students indicate whether they will require financial assistance or not. Students must submit an explanation for need of the grant and submit the past two years financial tax returns to support their claim. If the need for assistance is approved, CreatEd Institute grants up to \$4,000 to the student, divided into four semester payments of up to \$1,000. The awarded amount is deducted from the student's overall costs, and applied by the billing department each semester.

Norment Grant

In honor of their call to serve and empower the next generation, the Norment family, the founders of CreatEd Institute, along with other families that support CreatEd Institute, have donated funds to be allocated for students with the greatest need. Students who have severe financial circumstances and are unable to attend CreatEd Institute even with all the financial aid options above may qualify for the Norment Grant. Students who are requesting aid from the Norment Grant must have submitted their application with the requirements for the CreatEd Grant and schedule a personal meeting with Bobby Norment and Peter Ikeda from CreatEd Institute and whomever is financially responsible for their tuition (ex: parents, supporters, etc.). The grant is awarded to students at the discretion of the Institute and is allocated in amounts based on the needs of the individual student. Student Part-Time Work

To offset the expense of the program, a majority of our students choose to work part-time in the local Black Mountain/Asheville community.
