1: Students may pay by month (if enrolled in an automatic payment plan) or per semester, which divides the 16-monthly payments in 4 installments over the course of the program. For more information, please contact billing@creed.education.

2: Five meals included per week (Monday through Friday dinners) for \$100 per month. For other meals, students have access to a full kitchen and will be responsible to budget and prepare for themselves.

3: Enrollment scholarship is awarded to students who begin their application and make their deposit within 30 days.

4: CreEd Grant can be applied for directly on the application, under the "Financial Aid" section.

5: \$125 discount available for those making automatic monthly payments or who pay upfront on a semester basis.
